



TOWN OF EDEN NY RECYCLING AND REFUSE GUIDELINES

IMPORTANT CHANGES TO YOUR RECYCLING COLLECTION

- **Beginning on January 1st 2018, recycling will now be collected on an every other week basis.** The first week of January 2018, the entire Town of Eden will be serviced for recycling. After the first week, the recycling service will be every other week. Therefore, the next scheduled recycling week service will be the week of January 15th, 2018, and continuing every other week after.
- Recycling will be collected utilizing the new Town of Eden branded wheeled totes, which are the property of the Town. These carts may not leave the residence to which they are delivered.
- The recycling totes will be collected with an automated truck with mechanical arm. Recycling will only be collected in the provided wheel carts. All recycling material must be placed inside the tote, any recycle material that is placed outside the tote will not be collected.
- With automated collection, it will be very important for the resident to follow these set-out guidelines:
 - Do not place within 4 feet of the trash tote, your mailbox, or any fixed structure or object.
 - Place cart within 2 feet of curb.
 - All recyclables must be in the tote.
 - Handle of cart should be facing the house, as described on cart lid.

Dear Eden Residents

Effective January 1st, 2018, 96 Gallon wheeled totes, owned by the Town of Eden, will be used for both the collection of trash and recycling. Each tote has a serial number on it, which matches it to the address it will be delivered to. If a resident would like an additional 96 Gallon trash tote, or an additional 96 Gallon recycle tote, it may be purchased through the town, and used for your regular service. Your current small, green recycle bin can be kept if desired. If you would like to dispose of, they will be collected the first week of January for addresses that are serviced on Tuesday and Wed. on your large trash pick-up day. (see attached schedule). All addresses serviced on Thurs and Friday, please put the small recycle bin out for disposal the first week of February. For disposal of old trash bins, for all addresses serviced on Tuesday and Wed., put out the old bin on your pick-up day the first week of March, for all addresses serviced on Thursday and Fri., put the old bin out on your regular trash day the first week in April. If possible, please mark "please dispose of" on a sign attached to the bin to alert the driver to take the bin..

Service Day

All households in the Town will have their garbage serviced weekly. However, recycling will be serviced every other week. ****please note, some household's service day for refuse and recycling has changed, please refer to the attached service day listing**.**

Garbage Set-out Limits

All refuse (trash bags, general trash), must be contained inside your new 96 Gallon tote. Garbage must be placed within 2 feet of the street curb by 6:30am of your collection day. All waste must be contained inside the 96 Gallon tote. No trash can be set next to the tote. The trash tote will be picked up with an automated truck with a mechanical arm.

Bulky Waste and White Goods (Appliances)

Waste Management will collect one (1) bulky item and one (1) white good (appliance) the first full week of each month. For example, the first full week of February 2018 is February 5th through 9th. White goods will be collected separately from your household waste and recycling. Refrigerators and freezers must have doors removed and refrigerant (freon) must be removed by certified service with unit stickered as "Freon removed".

Bulk pickup schedule- The Week of Jan 1st, Feb 5th, March 5th, April 2nd, May 7th, June 4th, July 2nd, Aug 6th, Sept 3rd, Oct 1st, Nov 5th and Dec 3rd.

- ✓ Carpeting must be rolled in lengths of 4 feet or less, taped securely, and no wider than 18 inches.
- ✓ Large items must be of size that can easily be handled by two employees.
- ✓ Additional acceptable items include small furniture, bedding and mattresses, hot water tanks, and large appliances.
- ✓ The term does NOT include air conditioners, microwave-emitting equipment, microwave ovens, and regulated material covered by the New York State Electronic Equipment Recycling and Reuse Act.
- ✓ Any item, such as a weed trimmer or small lawnmower, with an engine requiring oil and gas must have those liquids removed prior to collection.

Unacceptable Waste

Dead animals, explosive and flammable materials, pesticides, batteries, compressed gas cylinders, aerosol cans, motor oils, regulated and non-regulated hazardous, pathological, medical, infectious, construction, remodeling, and septic waste, sludge, junk automobiles, recreational vehicles (ATV's). **TIRES ARE NOT ACCEPTED.** For more information on disposal of household hazardous waste such as oil and lead based paint, pesticides, antifreeze, etc. contact Erie County Hazardous Waste at 858-6800 or visit www.erie.gov/environment.
