EWC Code of Conduct

1. Wrestlers, parents, and coaches will display good sportsmanship at all times. All must act respectfully towards others, to include towards coaches, parents, and wrestlers. No abusive or profane language will be tolerated.

2. Wrestlers must be attentive, listen, and follow coaches' directions.

3. Wrestlers should be prepared to begin when practice commences. Please try to be on time.

4. Wrestlers, parents, and coaches are guests of Eden Jr/Sr High School or any other facility attended during organized practice or competition. School grounds/property will be respected. This includes hallways, bathrooms, drinking fountains, and wrestling area.

5. Coaches will be made aware of any injuries or illnesses immediately when they occur. Bumps, bruises, scrapes, and nose bleeds will happen; let a coach know and assess the situation.

6. Any suspected head injuries will be brought to the attention of the head/lead coach immediately.

7. Parents will show respect to coaches and other parents at all times. Parents will allow coaches to instruct without interruption. Except in an emergency, parents will not interfere with practice, meetings, or coaching at any time. Any issues should be brought to the attention of the head coach.

8. Parents will be on time to pick up their child from practice.

9. Parents who attend tournaments will allow coaches to instruct their child during competition.

Wrestlers who are in violation of the EWC Code of Conduct may receive a verbal warning, suspension from practice, or dismissal from the team depending on the severity of the violation.

Parents who are in violation of the EWC Code of Conduct may be asked to remove themselves from the practice/competition and/or barred from attending future practices/competition. Any parent who refuses to comply may result in the dismissal of his/her child from EWC.
