

The Erie County Department of Environment and Planning has set dates for three public forums to determine the needs and priorities of the almost 100,000 low and moderate income residents residing within the Erie County Community Development (CD) Block Grant Consortium (Excludes Buffalo, Amherst, Cheektowaga & Town of Tonawanda and the village's therein).

These forums will assist this office in obtaining information on community development needs and priorities in the Erie County outer suburbs and rural areas. Each forum will cover four (4) areas: housing, public / human services, community / neighborhood development and economic development needs. A review of Erie County CD Program performance, as required by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development, will also be presented.

The Department needs your help in encouraging low and moderate income residents to attend one of the three forums. The forum dates, times and locations are: Tuesday, September 11 – 7:00 pm – Village of North Collins Village Office Meeting Room, 10543 Main Street, North Collins; Wednesday, September 12 – 6:30 pm – Lackawanna Public Library – Community Room, 560 Ridge Road, Lackawanna; and Thursday, September 13 – 7:00 pm – Village of Lancaster Municipal Building, 5423 Broadway, Lancaster. We encourage you to attend one of the meetings to express your thoughts with respect to the community development needs and concerns of your low and moderate income constituents and/or clients.

The Department of Environment and Planning will, early next year, be preparing the 5<sup>th</sup> year Action Plan of the Five Year Community Development Consolidated Plan on behalf of the 34 Consortium municipalities and the Town of Hamburg.

We also encourage you to schedule your CDBG Public Hearing as soon as possible and remind you to contact your CD Monitor of the date, time and location of your Public Hearing.

You will be receiving a mailing from our office the week of September 3 regarding the annual Community Development Briefing meeting which will occur before the **Association of Erie County Governments** meeting on **September 27** at **Chef's Restaurant, 291 Seneca Street, Buffalo**. The documents in that mailing will assist you in scheduling your public hearings for community development.
