

ATTENTION EDEN RESIDENTS:

Town of Eden is having a Special Election to convert to Direct Service with Erie County Water Authority.

When: Friday, September 6, 2019, Noon until 8:00pm

Polling Location: Eden Town Hall, 2795 East Church St., Eden



The proposition on the ballot will read:

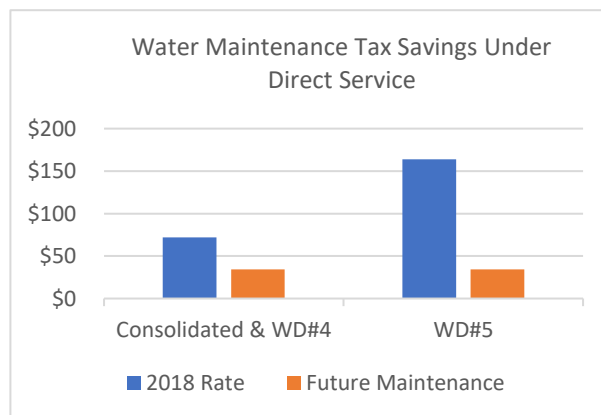
Shall the assets of the Town of Eden Consolidated Water District No. 2, except for the Wepax Road Service Area, be transferred to the Erie County Water Authority under a Direct Service Agreement?

What am I voting on: In order to move ahead with the transfer, property owners within the Eden Water District must approve the transfer of assets from the Town of Eden to the Erie County Water Authority.

Who is Eligible to Vote:

- Persons who own property in the Town of Eden Water District.
- Only those persons listed on the property deed can vote.
- Owners of multiple properties can only vote once.
- If a property is in Life Estate, only the person (s) with LE after their name(s) can vote.
- Corporations are entitled to one vote by a person designated by the corporation’s board of directors. Need a letter or board meeting minutes showing that they are authorized to vote.
- LLC are entitled to one vote by a person who is a member of the LLC. Need to present a certificate showing they are a member of the LLC.
- The Executor of an Estate may vote. Need proof of executorship.

Absentee ballots are available in the Eden Town Clerk’s office, 2795 East Church Street, Eden, NY. They must be delivered or postmarked by September 6, 2019 to the Eden Town Clerk’s office.
