8:00 p.m. Public Hearing Proposed Local Law #4-2011 2% Tax Levy Ceiling

Supervisor Nellis explained the purpose of the public hearing was to listen to any concerns or questions that citizens have.

Supervisor Nellis stated that the 2% tax cap was passed by the New York State Legislation on the tax levy ceiling for the total 2011 budget. A power point presentation packet was also provided, which is on file in the Town Clerk's office.

William Trask, Town Attorney stated that the property tax levy cap included the special districts. Mr. Trask suggested adopting the local law as contingency if it is necessary to exceed the cap they could do so, only for this year.

1. Submit Preliminary Budget - 2012. Set Public Hearing

Supervisor Nellis stated that the Preliminary Budget had been prepared and requested scheduling a Public Hearing for Wednesday, November 9, 2011 at 8:00 p.m. Supervisor Nellis provided the following information regarding the preliminary budget for 2012:

General	\$2.13
Highway	\$3.36
Light	\$.15
Fire	\$1.16
Total	\$6.80 = 30¢ increase or an increase of 4.6%
Garbage	\$155.00

On a property assessed at \$100,000, for these 4 items, there will be an increase of \$30. However, when you factor the \$34 savings on the garbage fee, there is actually a \$4 deduction on property assessed at \$100,000.

Water rates continue to be varied due to the multiple districts/projects we have in town. We are maintaining the same "Maintenance" Rate for our districts for $2012 - 40 \phi$ per thousand. Capital or construction rates are increasing because of Water District No. 5 and the Shadagee Road project.
