Call To Order:

Supervisor Nellis called the Work Session of the Eden Town Board to order at 7:40 P.M.

Pledge of Allegiance:

Supervisor Nellis led the assembly in the Pledge of Allegiance to the flag followed by a moment of silence.

New and Unfinished Business:

1. Approve Bid for Green Street/Depot Street Consolidated Water Project

Mark Cavalcoli, CRA stated that four bids had been received on March 12, 2015 at 10:00 a.m. with the following results:

MOTION was made by Councilman McLaughlin to award the bid to New Frontier Excavation and Paving, Inc., at a total bid amount of \$442,568.00, based upon the recommendation of Mark Cavalcoli, CRA and to authorize Supervisor Nellis to sign all necessary documents; seconded by Councilman Krycia; All "Ayes"; Opposed? – None; Abstain? – None; Motion carried.

Note: Councilman Krycia made the observation that New Frontier Excavation and Paving, Inc. was the low bidder and from Eden, New York.

2. Health Insurance Review and Approval

Supervisor Nellis stated that a meeting was held with Vanner Insurance Representatives and they presented the cost/benefit of our current Insurance carrier, Independent Health and a comparison with Blue Cross and Blue Shield. After much discussion with the employees enrolled in the insurance plan it was decided to consider the Blue Cross Blue Shield Plan State POS 7100 – Silver, with similar benefits.

MOTION was made by Supervisor Nellis to change Health Insurance benefits to Blue Cross Blue Shield Plan State POS 7100 – Silver effective May 1, 2015; seconded by Councilman Krycia; All “Ayes”; Opposed? – None; Abstain? – None; Motion carried.

4. Extended Hours – Supervisor’s Office

Supervisor Nellis stated that the hours of Lisa Winter, from 33 hours per week to 37 hours per week, with an increase of \$3,480 and Lisa Greiner, from 33 hours per week to 35 hours per week with an increase of \$1,671.20, would increase effective immediately; to be more consistent with the other offices in the Town Hall, but that their hourly rate would not change, the additional increase is for additional hours worked.

MOTION was made by Supervisor Nellis to adjust the hours of Lisa Winter from 33 to 37 hours per week with an increase of \$3,480.00 and Lisa Greiner from 33 to 35 hours per week with an increase of \$1,671.20; seconded by Councilman McLaughlin; All “Ayes”; Opposed? – None; Abstain? – None; Motion carried.
