WHEREAS, pursuant to the authorizing resolution of the Eden Town Board dated January 13, 2016 bids were received for the new ambulance in accordance with bid specifications prepared by the Eden Emergency Squad, and

WHEREAS, officers of the Eden Emergency Squad have reviewed the bid results and have recommended awarding the contract to Northeastern Rescue Vehicles as the lowest responsible bidder at a price of \$159,720.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby

RESOLVED that the Eden Town Board does hereby award the contract for the new ambulance to Northeastern Rescue Vehicles as the lowest responsible bidder at a price of \$159.720.00, and it is further

RESOLVED that Supervisor Missy Hartman is authorized to execute all contracts and other documents required to proceed with the purchase of such ambulance subject to funds being available pursuant to further authorizing resolution(s) of this Board if required.

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING SUPERVISOR MELISSA M. HARTMAN TO EXPEND FUNDS FROM THE AMBULANCE EQUPMENT RESERVE FUND OF THE TOWN OF EDEN, SUBJECT TO PERMISSIVE REFERENDUM.

The Town Board of the Town of Eden, duly convened in regular session, does hereby resolve pursuant to the provisions of Section 6- of the General Municipal Law of the State of New York that the Town Supervisor of the Town of Eden be and is hereby authorized and directed to transfer from the Ambulance Equipment Reserve a sum not to exceed \$160,000.00 from said Reserve Fund to purchase a Ambulance-Emergency Vehicle, as per replacement schedule.

This resolution shall be subject to a permissive referendum, as permitted by law.
