Supervisors Report:

Supervisor Hartman was happy to report a great year of The Eden Corn Festival mentioning how nice it was having the community and organizations back together. Supervisor Hartman thanked the Corn Fest Committee as well as all the Eden Corn Fest volunteers.

Supervisor Hartman discussed a TAP grant for pedestrian safety and enhancements along parts of Route 62. Application for the federal transportation grant is due at the end of September.

Supervisor Hartman stated that the Town of Eden successfully submitted an application for a second Main Street grant. Supervisor Hartman reported recycling tote grant funding was received by town. This grant paid for 50% of the towns recycling totes.

Hearing of Visitors:

Peter Beljan Town of Eden resident spoke briefly about "Divide New York", Mr. Beljan presented to the Eden Town Board a 3-page outline. Although he is not a member of the group Mr. Beljan felt inclined to address the Eden Town Board due to the interest it sparked for him about New York State & New York City having autonomous zones and regions. Mr. Beljan stated although it was entirely up to the Eden Town Board, he felt it was an interesting item to bring to the Eden Town Boards attention for a possible future agenda item.
