- WHEREAS, she has worked countless hours for the benefit of our town residents, their families and children through recreational programming and the oversight of building and grounds maintenance, and
- **WHEREAS**, Amy's contributions to our community's youth are to be commended, specifically in her revamping of the summer recreation program especially through the covid-19 pandemic, and
- **WHEREAS**, under Amy's leadership, she was able to start many new programs, including the annual Slow roll event, Youth Activity Night, Stargazing, Pickleball and Family Night Swim Program.
- **WHEREAS**, Amy was also able to resurrect Eden's Annual Winterfest, a long-time favorite weekend for our residents, and
- WHEREAS, her many contributions to the success of the Town of Eden including the office of Town Supervisor, Town Board and individual departments are deeply appreciative, join us in saying "thank you" to Amy Porter for her public service,
- **NOW, BE IT RESOLVED**, that, by act of this Town Board meeting on March 8, 2023, we honor Amy Porter for her dedication to the Town of Eden and its residents.

### 9. Climate Smart Pledge:

# **Climate Smart Communities Pledge**

**WHEREAS**, the New York State Climate Smart Communities ("CSC") program was created to provide local governments with guidance on how to improve environmental stewardship, save taxpayer dollars, and advance community goals for long term community health, safety, economic vitality, resilience, and quality of life; and

**WHEREAS**, the State makes available grant funding for projects to increase natural resiliency to future risks like floods, improve emergency preparedness and response systems, and increase the resiliency of critical infrastructure through the Climate Smart Communities Grant program; and

**WHEREAS**, Climate Smart Communities receive an advantage over non-participating communities during the Climate Smart Grant scoring process; and

**WHEREAS**, CSC certification requires adopting a non-binding Resolution which includes the specific ten-point pledge developed by the State, and appointment of a Climate Smart Coordinator; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town Board of the Town of Eden believes it in the best interest of the Town to become a Certified Climate Smart Community and to adopt the CSC pledge; and

**WHEREAS**, adopting the CSC pledge does not obligate or bind the Town to take any specific action and participation in the CSC program is voluntary and without cost to the Town;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Town of Eden, adopts the New York State Climate Smart Communities pledge, which comprises the following ten elements:

- 1. Build a climate-smart community.
- 2. Inventory emissions, set goals, and plan for climate action.
- 3. Decrease energy use.
- 4. Shift to clean, renewable energy.
- 5. Use climate-smart materials management.
- 6. Implement climate-smart land use.
- 7. Enhance a community resilience to climate change.
- 8. Support a green innovation economy.
- 9. Inform and inspire the public.
- 10. Engage in an evolving process of climate action.
