#### Susan Wilhelm:

• Library: in 2023 Eden Library welcomed 15,913 patrons through their doors who collectively checked out 46,592 items, used computers 1,350 times and accessed the library's WIFI network 2,114 times. 1,351 people attended 129 in-house programs during the year, with offerings for all ages. Program attendance increased 33% over 2022; the number of program offerings increased 54%.
